GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Ocean View Christian Academy graduates are required to earn a minimum of **52 credits**; one for each semester class passed with a “D” or better.

- **4** semesters – Language other than English (L.O.T.E.)
- **2** semesters – Visual or Performing Arts (*Drama, Art, Music*)

- **8** semesters – General Electives (*Culinary Arts, Journalism/Yearbook, Computers*)
